

Essential Services Provided Effective March 21, 2020

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Due to concerns over the possible spread of COVID-19 in our community, LFN Chief & Council have decided to take a precautionary measure and suspend all non-essential LFN services until further notice. This is to protect the health and well-being of our community, our members, and the staff.

The following services will continue to be provided to our members:

- **Health Services:** Members requiring health support not related to COVID-19 should contact Health Services staff at 536-5201;
 - Medications will continue to be delivered as usual;
 - To limit your movement in the community, please consider having your appointments at the Medical Clinic by phone.
 - Before requesting transportation from the LFN Health Services, you must confirm your appointment with the Medical Clinic's staff at 536-2565. For transportation, please call Audrey Chief at 536-5222;
 - **If you suspect you might be infected with COVID-19, please call 811 and follow the latest guidelines and recommendations! Do not come to the clinic before speaking to a health care professional about your concerns! Do not attempt arrange a ride;**
 - NIHB will continue to be processed.
- **Income Assistance** forms and other paperwork required can be dropped off at the Band Office between the hours of 10 and 11:30 am and 1:30 and 3 pm. Members are asked not to congregate in the Band Office lobby. Only one person at a time will be allowed in the lobby area.
- **Dena Keh Justice** services will continue by appointment only. Call 536-7925 for information on upcoming court dates and to arrange for all Justice related appointments.
- **Maintenance** emergency number is 536-5124.
- **Water Delivery** and **Garbage Pickup** schedules will remain the same.
- **Soup Kitchen** will continue to operate from 10:30 to 12:30 pm for sandwich take-out only.
