Job Description:

Liard First Nation is seeking a skilled and experienced Linux System Administrator to join our team. As a Linux System Administrator, you will be responsible for the implementation, administration, and maintenance of our Linux-based systems and infrastructure for the Kaska “talking” Dictionary. You will work closely with our previous software developer and an IT professional to facilitate a successful handover of the project and to ensure smooth operation of our system going forward. The ideal candidate should have strong organizational skills, attention to detail, and excellent written communication abilities, and once trained, the ability to work independently.

Responsibilities:

- Install, configure, and maintain Linux operating system and related software.
- Monitor system performance and troubleshoot issues involving UBC-based virtual server, network, database system, and applications.
- Perform regular system backups and implement disaster recovery plans.
- Manage user accounts, permissions, and access controls.
- Monitor security vulnerabilities and implement appropriate measures to protect data.
- Collaborate with development team to deploy applications and provide necessary support.
- Document system configurations, processes, and procedures.
- Stay up to date with emerging technologies and industry best practices.
