The Liard First Nation (LFN) Language department is looking for a Cook for **Hide Tanning and Language Camp at Two Mile Lake**. The Cook will be responsible for the planning and shopping ahead of time, and preparation of food and beverages for breakfast, lunch, and snacks during the Hide Tanning and Language Camp May 6th – May 24th, 2024. The Cook will take direction from the Language Director on the requirements for food and beverage service. The cook can request a helper they would like to work with. There will be an additional day for prep and reimbursement for fuel travel.

Main Duties

- Cleans food preparation areas as determined by law and policy.
- Prepares foods for the Hide Tanning and Language Camp at Two Mile Lake.
- Adjusts food items to accommodate guests with allergies or specific diet concerns.
- Ensure proper food service temperature.
- Purchase's ingredients and spices as needed through PO issued by the director.
- Estimates expected food consumption.
- Prepares any necessary sauces or accompaniments before meal service begins.
- Cleans up after each day.
- Makes sure the kitchen is clean and free of any leftovers after the last day of the gathering.
