## Job Summary

Reporting to the Director Health and Social, the Health Coordinator is responsible for ensuring the delivery of health services for Liard First Nation members. The incumbent will be responsible for researching, identifying, developing, recommending, and deploying health programs; liaising with other individuals, organizations and governments to build effective partnerships and obtain resources for health programming; and ensuring all clients are able to have full and equitable access to available Non-Insured Health benefits by providing information and support as required.

## Education and Experience

- A post-secondary degree in health, social sciences, or relevant field and/or equivalency obtained through coursework and/or experience is required.
- Experience working in a Health setting, facilitating or facilitating the provision of health programs to clients
- Experience working with Youth and/or Elders is an asset.
- Excellent computer skills (MS Office and other programs)
- Demonstrated excellent interpersonal, relationship-building skills
- Satisfactory Criminal Records Check
- Knowledge, respect and understanding of LFN culture, traditions and language are considered an asset.

- Strong verbal and written communications skills.
- Ability to work pleasantly and effectively with a wide range of people of different ages and cultures, in potentially volatile and emotionally charged situations.
- Ability to work respectfully with others in a cross-cultural environment.
- Knowledge of Liard First Nation history, culture, traditional territory, and demographics.
- Tact, intuition and diplomacy, strong work ethics and good judgment and ability to work well in a team environment.

## Conditions of Employment/Working Conditions

- This position will be required to travel within and outside of the Yukon.
- Some overtime and weekend work will be required.
