Questions/concerns

- Agree we need a constitution, but here it wasn't done in a transparent way
- People want to see the 1998 Constitution
- Will Chief and Council abide by the Constitution?
- Main reason for Watson Lake not meeting with Lower Post is disrespect
- Chief explained the various financial issues that happened prior to his leadership, lots of financial audits now – the nation is doing better
 - o Issues when the nation fell into third party organization
 - o CFO spoke as to how the nation was doing – consolidating transparent financial reporting
- Unity needed – the nation is fractured
- This affects other Kaska territory
- Some members required further consultation for the constitution process
- Off reserve members would really like having more community meetings like this one and be consulted
- The website has not been updated for many years -> this should be addressed.
- Some members suggested that the tenure for Council should remain at 3 years instead of 4.

Suggestions heard

- Have a building between Lower Post and Watson Lake
- Offer online voting and in person voting options
- Mediation proposed
- Some want to have a national kaska constitution (with Daylu Denae Council)

Other points highlighted/discussed at this meeting

- 4 year term -> to align with provincial/federal and territorial elections
- Not for the upcoming election just for the future
