The successful candidates will be supported in their participation in relevant training and certification.

- High school diploma or equivalent in experience is an asset
- Experience working with a variety of tools as a labourer or technician an asset

Knowledge & Skills

- Knowledge of general construction duties - use of tools, PPE, safety practices, weather protection, codes/regulations, etc.
- Familiarity with HVAC systems
- Knowledge of Liard First Nation history, culture, traditional territory, and demographics an asset
- Ability to work pleasantly and respectfully with others in a cross-cultural environment
- Good judgement, a strong work ethic, and the ability to work well in a team environment
- Ability to maintain accurate records of the details of work completed
- Attention to detail

Conditions of Employment/Working Conditions

- Travel within LFN communities (Yukon and BC) is required. Occasional travel within and outside the territory may be required.
- Some overtime and weekend work may be required, including response in the event of an emergency.
- This position will work indoors and outdoors in all weather conditions, including rain, snow, extreme temperatures and conditions.
- Physical fitness is required to manage equipment, ladders, etc. and to access HVAC systems and ducts, and climbing in and out of trucks
- Class 5 Yukon Driver's License (Class 3 preferred)
- Must be able to carry up to 50 lbs. and be physically fit
- Physical fitness is required to manage equipment, access HVAC systems and perform manual labour for up to 8 hours per day
- WHMIS, Basic First Aid/CPR or ability and willingness to obtain (provided)
- Willingness to complete the First Nation 101 course
- Ability and willingness to attend and complete all training as provided or directed by the supervisor
